

Getting a learner's permit in Virginia:





Age minimum: 15 years and 6 months



Visit the DMV website\* for details and required documentation



Must pass a two-part **knowledge** test and a **vision** test



Getting a driver's license in Virginia, if under 18:



Age minimum: 16 years and 3 months



Hold permit for at least 9 months



Pass an approved driver's education course



Complete behind-the-wheel training



Complete 45 hours driving with parent supervision including 15 hours at night



Some counties require a joint parent/teen traffic safety class \*\*



Most localities require a licensing ceremony Check with your city/county for details \*\*\*



## Driver restrictions until age 18:





Curfew – may not operate motor vehicle between midnight and 4 AM



Passenger – only one passenger under the age of 21

Limit does not apply to relatives



Things to remember when behind the wheel:



**Seat Belts** are required by all occupants. Passengers under 18 must use a seat belt or be in an appropriate child seat.



**Texting or using a cell phone** is prohibited while the vehicle is in operation.



Zero-tolerance for underage substance use or open containers. This applies to anyone in the vehicle.
